

- The emergency brake away switch was replaced.

The streetside front wheel seal was installed too far on one side causing the seal to wobble when the hub rotates. The seal was removed and a new seal was installed.









- Outdoor GFCI plug wiring was corrected.



Job Summary Information

• During the installation and testing of the emergency brake away switch, the battery that engages the emergency brakes was found and is dead. has the battery information and is going to install the new battery when he returns to repair the door locks. This battery needs to be in place and functioning before the trailer is towed on the highway.

• I recommend installing a <u>solar battery maintainer</u> if the trailer will be sitting for extended periods. This would be for both the emergency brake battery and the chassis battery that is located near the generator. Lead acid batteries self drain and over time they will be dead from not being used. Also the GPS transponder is connected directly to the rear battery and will slowly drain the battery over time.
